

Raised in Kentucky, we grew tobacco. It was a year-long endeavor for which we got paid once a year at the tobacco auction. I can still remember cutting tobacco even by a full moon when it had to be harvested. After a long day in the field, Dad and I

would work our way back to the old farm house knowing that Mom had been to the garden and picked some fresh tomatoes, boiled a few ears of fresh corn and made some of her great coleslaw. Always served with homemade bread. What a feast!

The tobacco crop had to be sold at auction in Louisville, KY, and Dad would take all us girls and sit us up on the tobacco crop. Guess he thought maybe he could get a better price if they knew he had mouths to feed. Mom and Dad would take us to the Blue Boar Cafeteria in Louisville to eat as part of our Christmas present—the only time we ever got to go out to eat. We could have anything we wanted but we had to eat it all... expensive to eat out, you know. We thought it to be heaven.

Perspective: now it is such a treat to eat home grown food. I seem to eat out more than I care to. Living alone and working the crazy schedule that I have, sometimes it is just easier to grab a bite and keep going. I am grateful as the tomatoes slowed me down this week and reminded me to cook at home a little more.

We have so much to be thankful for where we live. All of us have a roof over our head, food in our mouth, good health care, friends and the freedom to worship as we choose. I hold this truth as a vision for all on the planet.

The choir and I are writing down ten things we are thankful for every day. Please join us and continue to “Pray without ceasing.”

Leadership Council Communiqué

Dear Friends,

We are back from Italy, Mary and I, with many wonderful memories and photos. Perhaps someday we will be able to put together a slide show after we cull and sort our 700+ photos. We did a lot of gawking at masterpieces (paintings and sculptures) and old architecture and medieval churches; we bicycled through the beautiful Tuscan countryside; we walked a lot through narrow cobblestone streets; we sampled Tuscan balsamic vinegar, wines, cheeses and meats so we ate extremely well; we sampled the fare and ambiance in many picturesque sidewalk cafes; and enjoyed the company of our traveling companions. This was a once in a lifetime experience and we are extremely grateful for the opportunity to do this. This is surely not the end of our traveling adventures. We love the adventure of learning about new cultures, lifestyles, languages, landscapes and people and being surprised, and sometimes challenged, by every new experience.


Now we are back, glad to be on home turf, with friends and family and eager to share our experiences. There are now fewer surprises; most everything is as we left it. The challenges are still there. We had to finish our tax returns and resume our duties and responsibilities. United Life is calling and we are part of an exciting adventure in building up the church membership (The 100 Club), improving our building and grounds, and providing more opportunities for growth and participation in the church community. The LC is working as one mind to bring these things to pass. In our last meeting we agreed on the following wish list of projects to be accomplished as the money becomes available: finish the Sanctuary improvements; construct a handrail and handicap access for the Sanctuary stage; install a security camera; increase handicap parking and repaint the parking lot lines; replace the accordion doors in the social hall; remodel the kitchen and

replace some appliances; make the building and rooms more rentable; paint the outside trim; paint the youth rooms and reorganize them; remodel and re-plumb the bathrooms; replace the solarium blinds; and remove clutter, plant trees, and improve the landscaping. To accomplish these goals, we will need everybody to help as both workers and financial partners. We raised over \$15,000 to update the Sanctuary lighting and audio/visual and we will need to raise money for the above goals. Stay tuned.

The LC is involved in several ongoing projects right now. The Member Directory is being put together. We are working on next year's Budget. We have started the selection committee for new LC members. We are posting on the bulletin board the minutes from the LC meetings plus a financial expense/income bar chart. We completed the Green Sheet Questionnaire (Ideas List) about potential activities and fundraisers (you can still complete and turn in to the book store). We are planning the Thanksgiving Feast and Family Night. (We're looking for a Coordinator for a continuing family night.)

Finally, don't forget to sign up for the weekly email blast, *The Week at ULC* (again see the Bulletin Board) to stay in the know. We also have a great website, www.unitedlife.org, that is a great resource and a good place to send people who are interested in our church. We have a prayer request box and many Practitioners who are eager to support you with treatment and more. I have benefitted from using these services and believe that you will benefit as well.



INTRODUCING . . . Dr. Raymond Charles Barker (1911-1988)

Dr. Barker opened the First Church of Religious Science in New York City in 1946, was President of the International New Thought Alliance (INTA) and a well-known minister, author and teacher throughout the New Thought movement. He had grown up in New Thought, being trained at the Unity Training School, and prior to his election as INTA president in 1943, was minister at the Unity Center in Rochester, New York. He was later to affiliate with the Church of Religious Science and became the leader of the First Church of Religious Science in New York City and president of the IARSC. But his deep interest in INTA never flagged. He was probably the youngest person ever to be chosen INTA president and was very enthusiastic about it and entered actively into the affairs of INTA. He served on committees, attended congresses, worked in regional groups promoted by INTA, and in general warmly supported INTA in its various activities. His classic book, *Treat Yourself to Life* is often used in Religious Science classes. Dr. Barker explains how to change the subconscious pattern through spiritual treatment. Some of his statements: "There are unfortunately a great many people with attractive surface attitudes but with the same old rubbish underneath;" "If you fail to direct your subconscious mind, it produces under a law of averages, and you are a nice, ineffective, sweet person;" "I call treatment mind surgery. It is the way in which you go into the subconscious, destroy old patterns and instill new ones."

The following are two excerpts of his work and style of treatment work from the first edition of the *Creative Thought* magazine, December 1954.

What You Believe Happens . . .

No one has ever solved a problem by worrying about it. A repetition of negatives cannot create a positive. Yet, watch a worried person, and you will see him enmeshed in useless ideas that will have to be discarded before the solution appears. The past with its memory patterns is the millstone that hangs around the necks of most people. Jesus negated the past, affirmed the present in positive terms, and declared the future to be good. His way of thinking has improved the world. It can improve you. It is easy to think of the past, because it requires no new thinking. The ideas have already been alive once. But, to think ahead creatively requires your stepping out of accepted ideas. You have to make new friends in the realm of Mind. New ideas conceived guarantee new conditions to be perceived. Your immediate future is your present thinking made visible. You can only become what you now believe you are. Right thinking today about yourself is your only guarantee of right experience tomorrow. Affirm that you are a spiritual person receptive to God's Ideas, and let Life bring to pass the good you need and seek. It will do just that.

I DISSOLVE ALL TROUBLES

"The Lord is with you, you mighty one of fearless courage." — Judges 6 :12 (AMPC)

The Lord is my shepherd; I cannot want for any good thing. Every idea I need to meet the problems of this day are already provided by the Mind of God. These ideas are already within me at the spiritual center of my being. I now turn to them and welcome them into my consciousness. They quicken me with intelligence and cause right action. The dissolving power of God delivers me from all confusion. His Love guides me aright. I act with wisdom and speak with authority. My mind accepts this word and acts upon it now. I set my thinking on Divine Ideas. I will not be delayed by worry, fear or suspicion. Before me is the right solution and I am steadfast in expecting immediate results. Today, my good happens. There is no law of delay, God's Law is the only law. I now give my full attention to the Presence, Power and Mind of God. I accept my freedom from all problems and rejoice in my demonstrations now. And So It Is!!
